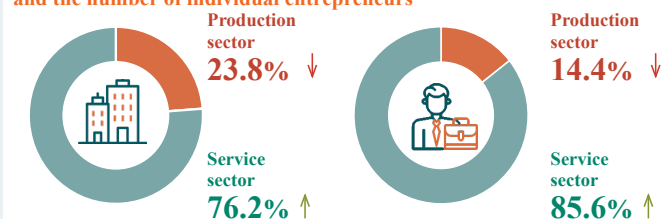

individuals engaged in individual entrepreneurial activities (including individual entrepreneurs);

small organisations - commercial organisations registered in the Republic of Belarus with average number of employees of up to 100 persons inclusive;

medium organisations - commercial organisations registered in the Republic of Belarus with average number of employees from 101 to 250 persons inclusive.

In several cases insignificant discrepancies between the total and the sums of data should be assigned to data rounding. Data for individual indicators are provisional and can be refined later on.

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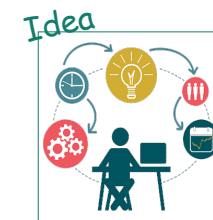

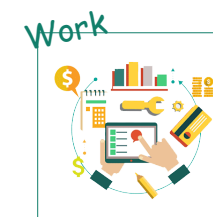

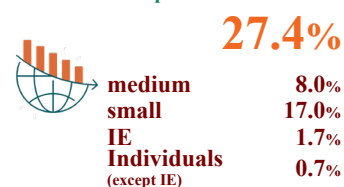

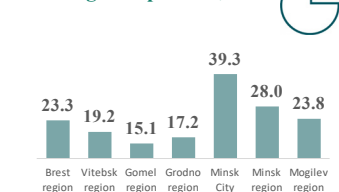

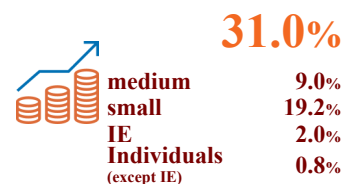

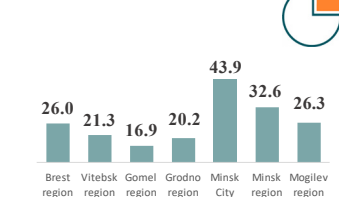
Gross regional product, %

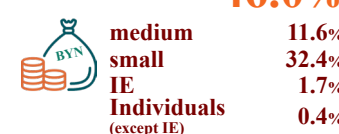

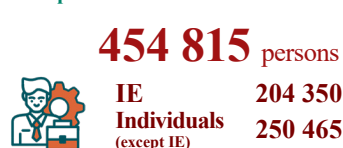

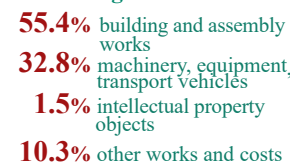
